Directions to Pistol License Office

- From Dunkin Donuts off Black River Blvd. in Rome enter Griffiss Technology Park on East Chestnut St. between Rite Aid and Burger King.

- Take East Chestnut to 2nd left to Hanger Rd.

- Go to end of Hanger Rd. the last building on the left is Building 45. (the old firehouse)

- Turn left and then go to the right around building. The last door is the Security Office and Pistol License Office. You can also enter the base from the Floyd Ave. Entrance. Go left at the traffic light and take the next right to Hanger Rd. The old firehouse is actually at the end of Brooks Rd. You could actually go straight ahead at the Floyd Ave. Traffic light to the firehouse except Rome Labs have

constructed a safety barrier on Brooks Rd. If you know your way around this barrier you can take this route.

NRA Readies AK-47 Suit

Scoffing at the idea that Mexican drug lords would fill out federal gun purchase documents, the National Rifle Association tells Whispers that it's launching a legal offensive against a new rule requiring Southwest gun dealers to report sales of more than one semiautomatic rifle like the popular AK-47. Justice Department officials say the requirement will help the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives keep the weapons out of the hands of drug gangs. But an NRA official tells us, "The whole premise that a \$40 billion transnational criminal enterprise, that according to recent reports uses submarines to transport their cargo, will pay attention to a paperwork requirement, is preposterous. The real issue here is the abysmal lack of prosecutions of gun crimes."

U.S. Senate Stands with NRA in Strongly Opposing U.N Gun Control Efforts

As of this morning, 51 members of the U.S. Senate have signed letters to President Obama and Secretary of State Clinton saying they will oppose any ATT that includes civilian firearms ownership. These strongly worded letters caution the President and Secretary of State to uphold the Constitution of the United States. Thanking the NRA for our long-standing work on this issue, Senator Moran remarked, "I appreciate the NRA's partnership on this important effort to defend the rights of American gun owners. I want to thank them for their active support in sending a strong message to the Obama Administration that our firearm freedoms are not negotiable."

U.S. House Committee Passes Amendment to Defund Illegal Obama Firearm Sales Reporting Requirement
Wednesday, July 13, 2011

Today, during consideration of the FY 2012 Commerce, Justice, Science Appropriations bill, pro-gun U.S. Rep. Denny Rehberg (R-Mont.) offered an amendment to prohibit the use of funds for a new and unauthorized multiple sales reporting plan proposed by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. The Amendment was passed by a vote of 25-16. The Rehberg Amendment, which was strongly supported by NRA, will defund the Justice Department's controversial and illegal move requiring federally licensed firearms retailers in states bordering Mexico to report multiple sales of semi-automatic rifles.
