Annual Family Fishing Derby!

Organized by: The Rome Rotary Club

Saturday, August 7, 2010, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 (noon), Bellamy Harbor Park, Rome, NY, on the NYS Barge Canal.

Registration (free) starts at 7:30 a.m., all participants must register to be eligible to win. Participants must have valid fishing licenses in accordance with requirements set forth by New York State (NYS). Participants must provide their own tackle. Worms will be available. No fishing will be allowed prior to the Derby start at 8:00 a.m.! Fish must be caught during the Derby, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon.

- All "game fish" presented for weigh-in must meet NYS minimum length requirements.
 - Fish must be caught in the canal between the Mill Street Bridge and the Arterial Bridge.
 - Weigh-in will be continuous, from 8:00 a.m. until 12 noon. Participants must be present to win and fish must be alive to be considered for award.
 - Door prizes provided by: Suffix Fishing Line and Carrera-Werner Sales Company, LLC, Wal-Mart Super Center, Herb Philipson's and Maurice Sporting Goods.
 - Worms will be available, courtesy of Morgan's Bait Distribution Services of Rome. A \$1-\$2 donation is suggested to help fund the cash awards.
 - Cash awards provided by the Bobby Page Memorial Foundation, the Stanwix Veterans and Men's Club, The Rome Specialty Company (manufacturers of fishing tackle in Rome, NY), and the Rome Rotary Club.
