

Rules of Conduct for Greenway-Verona Mills Fish & Game Club, Inc.

GENERAL CLUB RULES:

1. All members are responsible for their guests and the guest's conduct while on club property. The host member must accompany their guest at all times. **Guests may not shoot on the outdoor range.**
2. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the premises of the club unless authorized by the Board of Directors.
3. Causing willful damage to the Club property will be cause for that person to be suspended from membership. If you find any damage/vandalism at the club, contact an officer to let them know about it.
4. You must sign the log book when you arrive and depart.
5. In winter months, be sure to close the indoor range door before leaving.
6. If you wish to reserve the club facilities, you must attend a regular meeting early enough so that we can post the reservation in the monthly newsletter.
7. If you sponsor a new member, it is your responsibility to show them around the club and instruct them on the procedures for range and building usage.

INDOOR RANGE RULES:

1. All guns must be unloaded when entering or leaving the range. Personal protection handguns that are holstered are exempt from this.
2. Please read and obey all signs posted in the range. All switches are labeled with their purpose.
3. All shooters and visitors must wear eye and ear protection. Guests are allowed but members have priority use of the range.
4. **Keep the muzzle of the weapon pointed down range.**
5. Finger must remain outside the trigger guard until the weapon is pointed at the target.
6. Shotguns or shotgun ammunition are **NOT** allowed.
7. 500 S&W and 460 S&W are **NOT** allowed.
8. Center fire rifles are **NOT** allowed. Only .22LR rifles are allowed.
9. Place all misfired rounds in the receptacle designated for misfires.
10. Shoot only at approved targets. No plastic, balloons, empty shell casings, etc..
11. Keep the range door closed when shooting.
12. Record any unsafe or defective equipment on the white board over the sign in desk.
13. Do not litter the range. If you bring cardboard targets in, please take them back out with you when you leave. Pick up empty brass and put it in the buckets supplied.
14. Make sure you turn off all the range lights before leaving the club.
15. To shoot targets part way down range, a target stand with instructions is available in the range proper.
16. Never place targets on or near the floor.

OUTDOOR RANGE RULES:

1. Before using the outdoor range, sign in, blow the warning horn twice, and raise the flag on the pole at the shooting bench.
2. Range shall not be monopolized and courteous behavior shall be extended to fellow members. **Only members may shoot on the outdoor range. One day memberships are available inside the club house.**
3. Range hours are: M-Sat. 10AM- ½ hour before sunset, Sun. Noon- ½ hour before sunset.
4. **Always keep the weapon's muzzle pointed down range.**
5. Only shoot at targets attached to the provided backer panels. Shoot rifle and shotgun from the bench area, you may move forward to shoot handguns.
6. Do not leave targets. You must remove targets, pick up litter and brass and dispose of properly.
7. All guns must be unloaded when entering or leaving the range.
8. Fingers must remain outside the trigger guard until the weapon is pointed at the properly back-stopped target.
9. Misfired rounds are not to be left on the range, dispose of properly.
10. Shooting at targets such as glass, plastic, clay birds, balloons, etc. is prohibited.
11. Record any unsafe or defective range equipment on the white board over the sign in desk.
12. All shooters and visitors must wear eye and ear protection.
13. Follow all rules posted at the shooting bench. Absolutely no shooting over the top of the bunker.
